

Daisys Farm runs parties and workshops to teach children how to look after their first pet whilst at the same time learning to care for their environment. The learning process is combined with fun activities.

The pets involved, normally rabbits and guinea pigs, can be held and stroked. The children learn basic pet care skills and the responsibilities of animal ownership before gaining a certificate.

The children are also able to take part in nature projects using recycled materials encouraging them to look after their surroundings and appreciate the native wildlife.

Small pet workshops are intended to be quiet times for children to interact with the animals and introduce them to caring for local wildlife.

The parties are aimed for 4-10 year olds and we can have between 4 and 10 children at each party. They take place at our woodland base, or your home – assuming you have suitable space!
